CATEGORIES FOR ORIGINAL WORK:

All media: Painting, Mixed Media, Graphics,
Drawing, Sculpture, Photography and
Printmaking.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Work must be suitably framed and wired for
hanging. Dimensions may not exceed 48' on
longest side. Screws eyes and wire should be
placed 5" down from the top of the painting.

Work must not have been shown in any
gallery within 60 miles in the last six months.
Work on paper should be framed under plexi-
glass or glass.

Completed entry cards must be provided for
each piece of work, along with a self-
addressed stamped envelope. Do not separate
any section of the entry. Each entry must
have three sections and be placed on the
upper left back of the artwork.

ENTRY FEE:

Fifteen dollars for each entry. (non-refund-
able). Unlimited entries may be submitted.
Make checks payable to West Hartford Art
League or WHAL.

SALES

A 30% donation will be taken on all work
shown. All work must be for sale. No work
will be listed P.O.R.

SCULPTURE:

Sculptures may not weigh over 100 lbs.
Sculptors must provide their own white
bases.
